

Copyright Licensing Agency (CLA) Photocopying and Scanning Licence: Photocopying



Staff and students of Cardiff University are authorised by the CLA to make multiple photocopies of extracts from publications covered by the scheme, as follows:

Copying from any one publication for any one course or module must not exceed, either singly or in aggregate, the greater of 5% of a published work, or

- from a book – one whole chapter
- from a journal issue or set of conference proceedings – one whole article
- from a set of law reports – the entire report of a single case
- from an anthology – one short story or poem not exceeding 10 pages.

Multiple photocopies made of any one item for any one course or module must not exceed the number of copies needed to ensure that each student on the course has one copy.

The following categories of material are excluded from the Licence:

- Works published outside the countries participating in the licensing scheme*
- Works which specify on the publication that they are excluded, or which appear on the CLA's Excluded Works list*
- Printed music (including the words)
- Newspapers (licensed separately)
- Maps, charts or books of tables
- Public examination papers
- Privately owned documents issued for tuition purposes to clientele who pay fees
- Workbooks, workcards and assignment sheets
- Industrial house journals and other publications primarily for employees of commercial businesses, industrial undertakings or public services.
