

# Connecting to CU-WiFi Standard on Apple MAC OSx

*This document is a configuration guide for connecting to the Standard Security Cu-WiFi SSID wireless network service on Apple MAC OSx*

This is a two stage Process

1. Devices must be registered with INSRV to be able to connect.
2. Launch Web Browser

## 1. Registration of Wireless Devices with INSRV

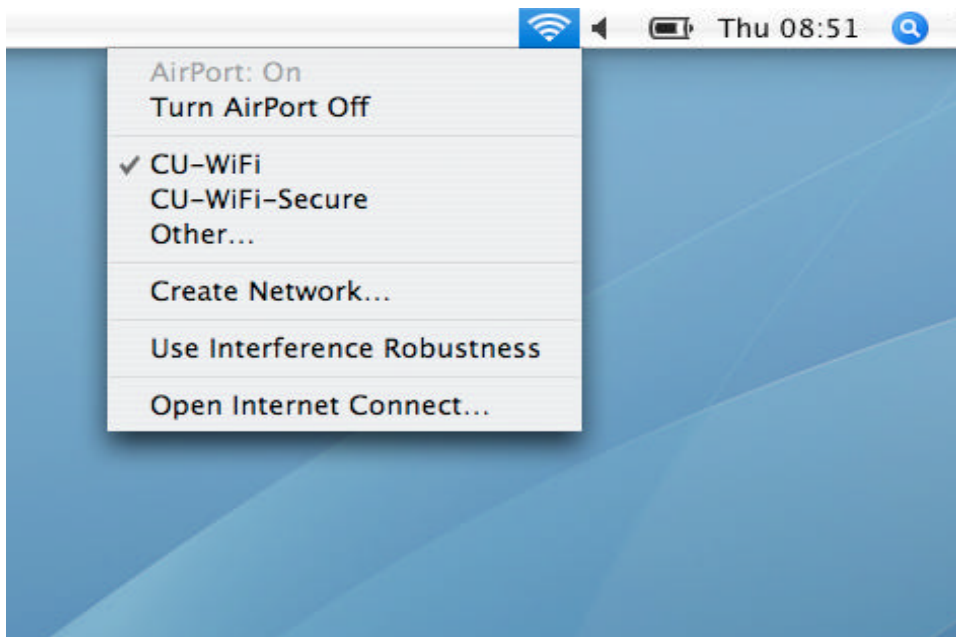
It is a requirement that any device connecting to the Cardiff University network *by any means* MUST have Cardiff University-approved anti-virus software installed and security updates applied (and set to update automatically). Once we are satisfied that is the case, you will be able to register your wireless network card for use on CU-WiFi. Please note that anti-virus software is provided, free-of-charge, to all members of Cardiff University. For full details on how to register your device, see

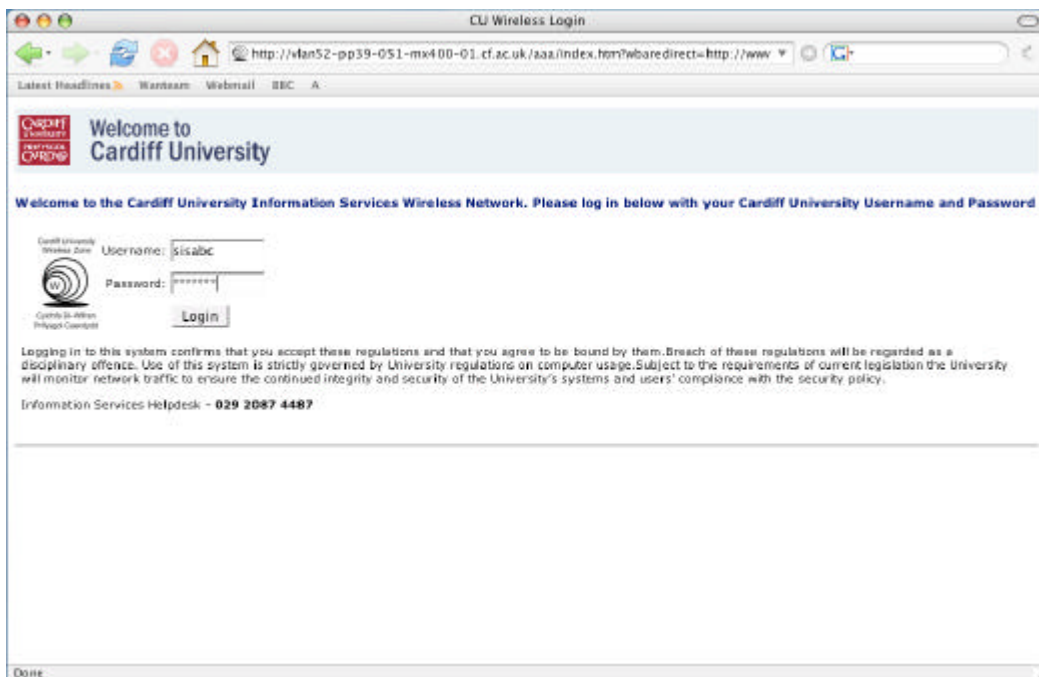
## 2. Connection via a web browser

1. Proceed to an area that has wireless coverage.
2. Turn on your computer.
3. Turn on your wireless network card (if it is not already turned on). Please refer to your manufacturer's instructions on how to do this.

- Click the wireless icon on the top bar as shown in the image below, and select the "CU-Wifi" SSID.



- Open a browser such as Safari, and attempt to load a web page "www.cardiff.ac.uk". The Wireless Login page will load automatically. Input your usual Cardiff University username and password to connect to the standard wireless service



- You are now connected and may access the World Wide Web but please note that we strongly advise you to also register for the CU-WiFi Enhanced service. Traffic on the enhanced service is encrypted and staff/research postgraduates may also have additional access rights.
