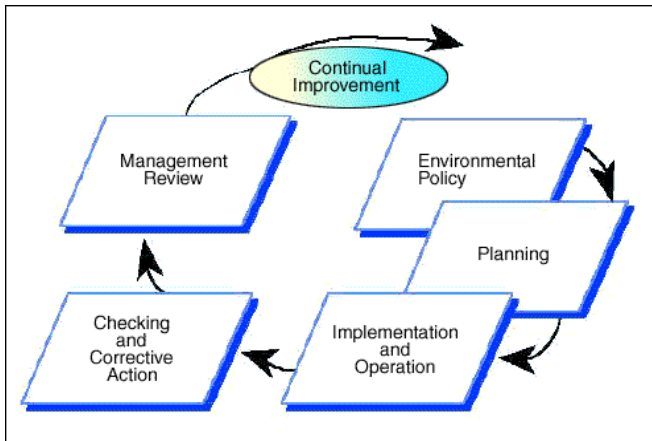


## The University and its Environmental Management System What you need to know

### What is it?

An Environmental Management System is a formalised approach to identifying and managing an organisations environmental impact. Such a system is key to identifying the environmental issues to be considered as part of broader sustainability aims.

### What is Cardiff doing?

Cardiff is committed to rolling out its Environmental Management System to the entire campus. To facilitate this, a pilot project (funded by HEFCW) will trial implementation in one Directorate and two academic Schools.



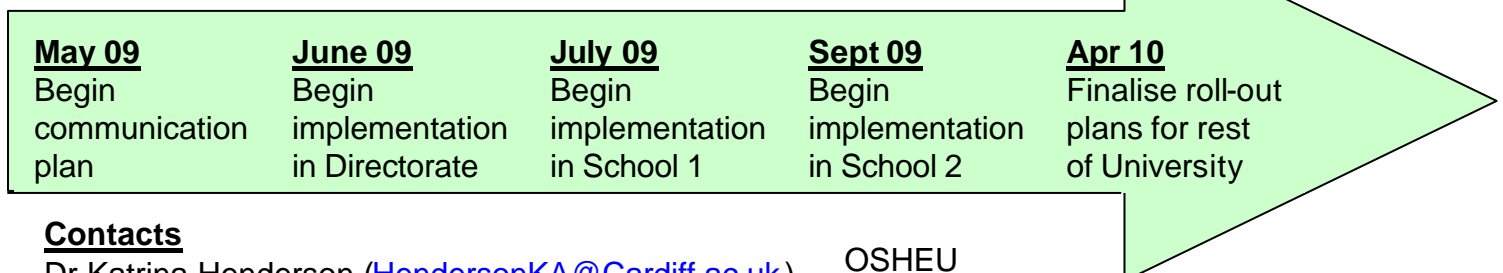
