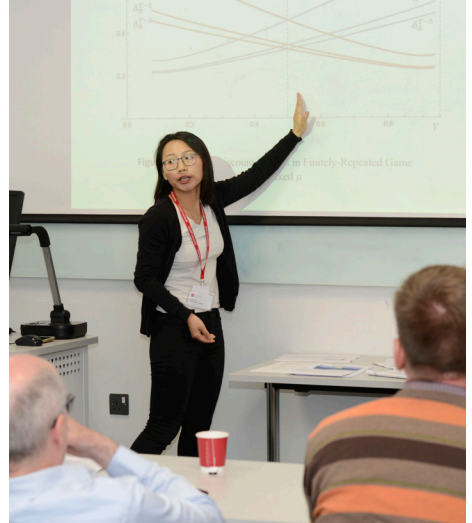
OUR APPROACH

FUNDING

Our PhD programme offers studentships and scholarships to UK, EU and overseas applicants and are Economic and Social Research Council (ESRC) recognised.

Funding is available via the ESRC Wales Doctoral Training Partnership, with studentships available in Business and Management, and Economics. We also offer funding through the Cardiff Business School scholarship.
