10am to 4pm on the first day of your Contract Period (as stated on your online Contract Acceptance – Key Matters)

If you do not collect your room key by 4pm your allocated residence may be withdrawn and the room offered to another student.

Arriving by public transport:

If you are arriving at Cardiff Central railway or bus station:

Taxi – Taxis are easily available from the taxi rank which is located outside the Cardiff Central railway station and Cardiff Central bus station. These will cost about £15 depending on the distance and how much luggage you are carrying.

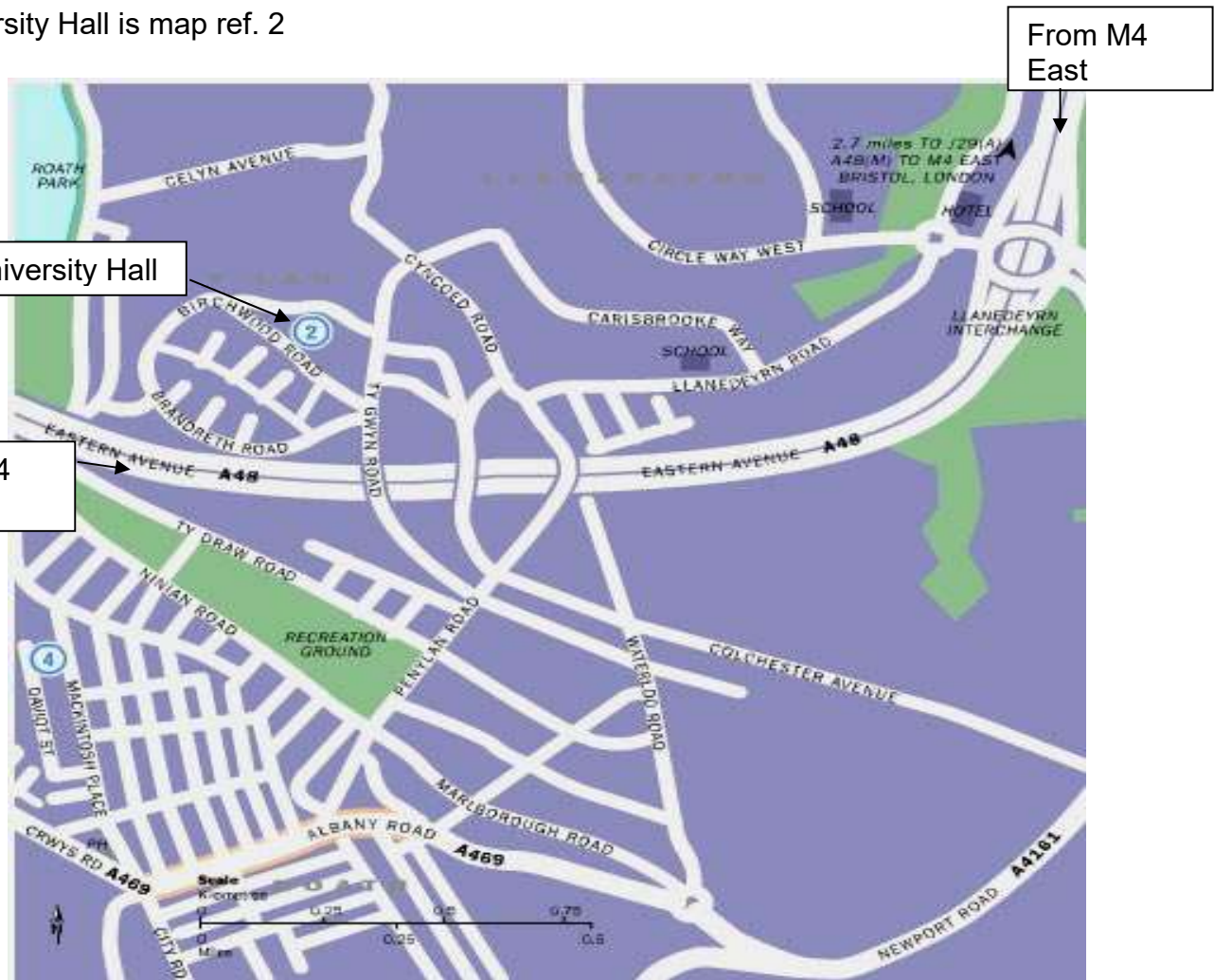

Is car parking available?

Important: Parking enforcement operates on university carparks.

- There are temporary parking facilities on site for unloading, this is restricted to one car per student
- On key collection, you will need to provide your car registration details at reception
- Unfortunately, we can only allow 45 minutes to unload your vehicle due to parking restrictions
- After unloading on street parking is available in the local residential area
- Please check parking signs for restrictions and be respectful of local neighbours
- PAYG visitor parking may be available on the residences site, please check onsite signage
