To be eligible for a Cardiff DLA studentship you should normally have, or be studying for, a Master's degree or similar postgraduate qualification. If you do not have experience of formal postgraduate study, you should be able to evidence other ways in which your professional, voluntary, or other experience has prepared you for PhD-level study of your proposed research topic. Potential and aptitude for study may be evidenced by some or all of the following criteria:

- outstanding undergraduate and/or taught postgraduate degree results
- professional qualifications
- significant work or voluntary experience in a relevant area
- elements of the research proposal itself that show how you have already begun preparation or how previous experience will be used academically
- published work
