Each party must, at least 5 working days before the hearing, file at Court their documents upon which it intends to rely by CE-File, and for litigant in person by forwarding the same (TOTALING NO MORE THAN 50 PAGES) to the following e mail address:

Important note: in the subject line of your response please display 'Urgent Hearing, date and time as well as party v party and case number' Example: '**Urgent hearing 12/5/20 smith v jones cn:123456.**

If the above is not complied with, there is a real risk that documents that have been filed will not be before the Judge in time for the hearing. In that event, the hearing is likely to be adjourned with an adverse Order for costs being made against the defaulting party.

The estimated time of hearing is given above. If the hearing is not concluded within that time, the hearing is likely to be adjourned to another date with a new time estimate being given.

Cases are listed in accordance with local hearing arrangements determined by the Judiciary and implemented by court staff. Every effort is made to ensure that hearings start either at the time specified or as soon as possible thereafter. However, listing practices or other factors may mean that delay is unavoidable.
