**SPECIFIC INFORMATION FOR THE BSc IN DENTAL THERAPY AND DENTAL HYGIENE (B752)
PROGRAMME OFFERED BY CARDIFF UNIVERSITY SCHOOL OF DENTISTRY**

1.1 DENTAL THERAPY AND DENTAL HYGIENE

The Dental School offers:

B752 BSc (Hons) in Dental Therapy and Dental Hygiene (3 years)

This is a full time programme lasting three academic years.

1.2 ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

All applicants are expected to have a good understanding of the remit of the dental hygienist and / or dental therapist.

All applicants must have a minimum of five GCSEs/IGCSEs (or their equivalent). The minimum acceptable grade for GCSE /IGCSE being grade C unless stated otherwise. These GCSEs/IGCSEs must include:

GCSE / IGCSE English or Welsh First Language grade B or above.

All applicants must also have achieved:-

Three A-levels at grade B or above to include Biology or Human Biology

OR

A recognised Dental Nurse qualification together with 2 A-levels at grade B or above to include Biology or Human Biology.

1.2. i ENGLISH LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS

The programme is delivered and examined in English therefore there are requirements for proficiency in English language to be demonstrated at application (section 1.4 below).

1.3 IMPORTANT DATES

1.3. i RECEIPT OF APPLICATIONS

All applications must be received via UCAS by the 15th January. Late applications are not accepted.

1.3. ii INVITATIONS FOR INTERVIEWS

Applicants' who successfully come through the pre-selection process will be notified of such at least 2 weeks before the interview dates.

Applicants must attend at the given interview time; alternative times or dates are not possible.

1.3. iii CONFIRMATION OF OFFERS

Applicants who are successful at interview are generally notified with a period of 10 working days from the last interview date.

1.3. iv REJECTIONS

a. PRE-SELECTION PROCESS

Applicants who are unsuccessful in the pre-selection process are notified as soon as possible through UCAS.

b. AFTER INTERVIEW

Applicants who are unsuccessful at interview are generally notified within a period of 10 working days following the last interview date.

1.3. v HEALTH CHECKS AND CRIMINAL RECORD CHECK

Successful applicants will be required to undergo a Health Check and complete a Disclosure and Barring Service check. These must be completed and returned within the specified time frame before successful interview applicants will be allowed to enrol. 1.4 ENGLISH LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS

All applicants must possess an acceptable English Language qualification

1.5 QUALIFICATIONS FOR ENTRY TO BSC DENTAL THERAPY AND DENTAL HYGIENE (B752); UK BASED EXAMINATIONS

A-levels

Minimum three A-levels at grade B or above including one in Biology or Human Biology

OR

A recognised Dental Nurse qualification at Level 3 PASS plus two A-levels with one in Biology or Human Biology at a minimum of grade B.

General studies and Critical thinking are not considered suitable A levels for either of the programmes.

Where a grade A in the Extended Project Qualification is presented a typical offer will be BBC.

GCSEs / IGCSEs

At least five GCSEs/IGCSEs with minimum acceptable grades being grade C, however, they must include GCSE/IGCSE English or Welsh First Language at Grade B or above.

Access to Higher Education

Science based programme (with Biology or Human Biology).

60 credit pass required including 45 credits at level 3 (with 30 credits at distinction and 15 at merit).

Welsh Baccalaureate Advanced Skills Challenge Certificate

2 A-levels at grades BB, one of which must be Biology or Human Biology plus the Welsh Baccalaureate Advanced Skills Challenge Certificate to be achieved with an overall grade B in the core.

International Baccalaureate Diploma

A minimum of 34 points to include 5 points in Higher Level Biology or Human Biology and 4 points in Standard level English Language **(if not passed at GCSE grade B).**

Scottish Highers

BBBBB at Higher including Biology or Human Biology and English Language.

Scottish Advanced Highers

BB at Advanced Highers to include Biology or Human Biology.

Irish Leaving Certificate

BBBBBB2 at Higher including Biology or Human Biology and English Language.

Degrees

A minimum of 2ii Honours classification.

In addition, school leaving qualifications are taken into account and a minimum of B grades (to include Biology or Human Biology) at A-level

is required.

BTEC Qualifications

Only applicants taking the BTEC Level 3 Extended Diploma in Applied Science (Medical) to include Biology or Human Biology will be considered. DDM grades required.

Resit Students

Resit applicants are considered.

Overseas Applicants

Not Accepted.
