### **Travel Options**

As part of the University's commitment to managing the impact that transport generated by our activities has on the local environment and community, we encourage you where possible to travel to the University by sustainable modes of travel.

### **Sustainable Travel Options**

Cathays rail station is located at the heart of our campus and <a href="www.traveline.info">www.traveline.info</a> provides details of rail and bus options available. We also provide secure parking for those travelling by bike. Motorbike parking is available on site.

### Car Parking

Guests who wish to bring a car to the university whilst staying in Cardiff University accommodation will need to pre-book and pay for a space using RingGo.

Car parking is provided at Senghennydd, Colum Drive, Talybont North and University Hall at a cost of

- £3 for half day (4.5 hrs)
- £6 for a full day (up to midnight)

For guests staying 7 nights or more please contact the Travel, Transport and Parking services team by emailing <a href="mailto:carparking@cardiff.ac.uk">carparking@cardiff.ac.uk</a>

Parking is provided on a first come first served basis and must be pre-booked and paid for before arriving on site using the RingGo application or website. The code **39366** needs to be entered into RingGo to be able to search and book the car park.

**IMPORTANT**: This code is not included on the codes displayed on car park signage for Public Pay for Parking out of hours. Please book early as the number of bays is limited and demand is high. Please ensure that you park within a general parking bay if using our summer code. These bays are predominantly marked by white lines except for the gravel car park area at Senghennydd.

Automatic Number Plate Recognition (ANPR) technology is in place within our car parks and a foot patrol team support our compliance management.

#### Pick up/Drop off

Pick up / drop off bays and zones are identifiable by **Orange** markings and clearly signed 'Pick up and drop off only'. These can be used free of charge for a maximum stay up to 30 minutes.

### Car Parking - Blue Badge

If you are a blue badge holder there is no need to pre book and pay for parking however please note that you must email the Travel, Transport and Parking services team at <a href="mailto:carparking@cardiff.ac.uk">carparking@cardiff.ac.uk</a> to register your vehicle with their system prior to arrival. Those with a Blue Badge are eligible to park in an accessible parking bay or a general parking bay, free of charge, subject to a valid Blue Badge being clearly displayed in the vehicle windscreen. Accessible parking bays are identifiable by **Yellow** markings and clearly signed 'Blue badge parking only'.
